Footnotes:

*1 Students who have completed CHYS 1151 are not required to take CHYS 1120.

*2 PSYC 3319 is a prerequisite for CHYS 3320 (may be taken concurrently). CHYS 3320 is for students interested in adolescent/youth care.

*3 CHYS 3339 *Selected Topics in Child and Youth Study* OR CHYS 4429 *Special Topics in Child and Youth Study*. These courses, when offered, will be on selected/specialized topics. 0.5 unit can be counted as a program requirement. Interested 3rd and 4th year students may take an additional 0.5 unit Selected/Special Topics course as a professional elective (to be counted under ELECTIVES).

*4 Students must have Grade XI or Grade XII academic mathematics or equivalent or MATH 0020 with a grade of C or higher, or any 1000-level mathematics course. The 1000-level math course will count as an elective.

*5 See note *2

*6 **ELECTIVES.** In addition to the required 1.5 units Professional courses listed above under "A minimum of one and one half units from:" students may take an additional 1.5 units from this list which would count as Professional electives. This would allow students who want to take a comprehensive degree in Child and Youth Study to take up to 3.0 units of Professional courses. **For those considering applying to Education** following their CYS degree, please note that Professional electives do not constitute "teachable" subjects. Students who wish to apply to Education are strongly encouraged to consult the Academic Calendar under Bachelor of Education *Admission Requirements* and with their Child and Youth Study academic advisors in order to make appropriate selections for their elective courses.

BA(CYS) HONOURS

Students who wish to complete a BA(CYS) Honours degree must make application through the Department Chairperson by May 1 of the third year of the program or after completion of 15 units (see Child & Youth Study entry in MSVU Calendar for specific details) and complete CHYS 4499 Honours Thesis as one unit from the above courses listed under 'A minimum of one and one half units from.'
