Program Requirements:

- Both Thmt 2216 and Thmt 3316 require Restaurant Nights to be completed in addition to the regular required lab time. Students should choose days for Restaurant Nights when they have more time and flexibility.

- You may ONLY complete a practica-based BTHM if you meet ONE of the following criteria:
 - you had 7 ½ transfer credits when you were admitted to the BTHM degree program.
 - you have TWO full years of work experience in the tourism or hospitality fields.
 - you are completing your degree on a part-time enrolment basis.
 - you are completing your degree on a distance education basis.
