In Ways of Knowing II (Visual Art) we will consider visual art making as a means for personal reflection, as a way of seeing and communicating about our world, and as a method for teaching in a classroom setting. As an experiential course, we will be engaged in studio based art-making activities using a variety of media. We will examine the art processes and the content of our art as a visual language which expresses ideas, values and emotions. We will consider how these processes can be applied as viable activities in public schools and other contexts. Students will create art work in and out of class and will do further reflective written work considering learnings and the application of art techniques in the classroom or in other contexts where you live and work.

This course may be used toward the following programs of study.

- Educational Foundations: as an ed foundations (GFDD) designated course.
- Curriculum Studies: General: as a curriculum (GCRD) designated course.
- Literacy Education: as a literacy (GLIT) designated course.
- Elementary and Middle School Education: as a GEMS subject area course.
- Lifelong Learning: may be used toward the 1.5 unit of GSLL elective.
