This institute will use process drama, storytelling, personal narrative (currere) and playbuilding strategies to explore educational issues that classroom teachers have experienced. Much of the class will involve active participation, modeling the belief that drama is learning by doing, and reflection on that doing (Action Research). Public and personal stories will be used that will result in a collective performance performed for a select audience at the end of the institute. An evening field trip to a live performance will be part of this institute.

This course may be used toward the following programs of study.

- Literacy Education: as a literacy (GLIT) designated course.
- Elementary and Middle School Education: as a GEMS subject area course.
