- Arrange for **two official transcripts** from each previous post-secondary institution attended to be sent directly from the issuing institution(s) to MSVU's Admissions Office. Photocopies will not be accepted. **Official transcripts are required for all courses and degrees completed.** Please note that applicants do not have to submit transcripts for course work completed at MSVU.
- Transcripts and other official documents must be submitted **unopened, in their original format.** Transcripts submitted in a language other than English must be accompanied by an English translation signed by a notarized translator.
- Carefully read, sign and date the Certification section.
- Review the **Supplementary Information Package for Graduate Programs** and submit the following:
 - Referee Information Form
 - Resumé or curriculum vitae
 - Statement of Intent Form (Applicants to the MA (PR) and MPR must present this statement as an 800 word essay)

Language Requirements

- Students whose first language is not English must submit official reports with acceptable scores from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB), the CanTest, the International English Language Training System (IELTS) or the Canadian Academic English Language Test (CAEL). Scores must be sent directly from the relevant testing service to the Admissions Office.
- MSVU has partnerships with the East Coast School of Languages (ECSL), Canadian Language Learning College (CLLC) and International Language Institute (ILI) for training in English as a Second Language. Applicants who meet our admission requirements, but whose English skills do not meet language requirements, are referred to ECSL, CLLC or ILI for assessment.

** Additional Program Information

- Master of Education (MEd) does not include a thesis.
- Master of Arts in Education (MAEd) includes a thesis.
- SLDNE is the Supporting Learners with Diverse Needs and Exceptionalities concentration.
- TESL is the Teaching English as a Second Language concentration.
- The Human Relations concentration is being offered for both the 2008/2009 and 2009-2010 academic years.
- The Deaf/Hard of Hearing (DHH) and Blind/Visually Impaired (BVI) concentrations commence in July 2010 and are offered only every two years.

Internship Education Program (MScAHN degree program)

- The Internship Education Program is open to students enrolled in the Master of Science in Applied Human Nutrition. To be eligible, students must have fulfilled the undergraduate education requirements set out by the Dietitians of Canada. Applicants who are not graduates of a Dietitians of Canada accredited undergraduate program must have a program assessment done prior to admission to the internship.

- Applicants to the Public Relations graduate programs must present the statement of intent as an 800 word essay.

Reference Forms

- Completed Reference forms are required for all programs.
- Most programs require one academic and one professional OR two professional references, except:
 - **MA School Psychology:** requires two academic references and one professional reference
 - **MA Women and Gender Studies:** requires three academic references
 - **MSc Applied Human Nutrition, Internship Education Program:** requires one professional reference to be completed by a professional dietitian with active registration in either a Provincial Dietetics Association or a College of Dietitians, and one academic reference to be completed by a nutrition/dietetics faculty member.
- Send the appropriate reference form to your referee. The referee must send the completed reference form by fax or mail directly to MSVU's Admissions Office by the program deadline specified. Referees may also provide their reference to the applicant in a sealed, signed envelope to be mailed with the applicants' information, if preferred. Opened references will not be accepted by fax or mail from the applicant.

Applicants to the Public Relations Programs

- If you do not hold a Bachelor of Public Relations degree or equivalent, but do have 3 years of public relations work experience, you must submit a portfolio with your application. Return of the portfolio is at the discretion of the Department. Candidates who are accredited by the Canadian Public Relations Society or the International Association of Business Communicators are not required to submit a portfolio but should submit proof of accreditation.

Applicants to the Women and Gender Studies and Family Studies and Gerontology Programs

- Please include a sample of your writing that you believe demonstrates your potential as a graduate student. You may want to include a brief paragraph explaining why you consider your submission to be a good example of your potential to undertake graduate work.

Applicants to the Research Master of Arts Program

- Individual departments will interview selected applicants when applicable, make recommendations regarding admission, determine degree requirements and assign faculty advisors.
