Traditional

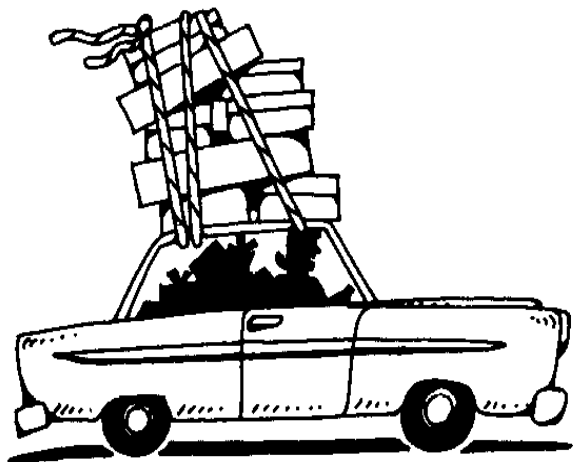
What should I bring if I live in a traditional residence?

- Residence Handbook and all correspondence from the Housing Office
- Linen - for a single bed (don't forget the comforter/duvet and a pillow)
- Alarm clock & Bedside lamp
- Computer with surge protected power bar and accessories
- Flashlight and batteries
- Sticky tack, 3M poster tabs, pins or thumb tacks. - absolutely no nails allowed for fixing things onto the walls
- Binders, markers, calculator, scissors...everyday supplies for class
- Over the counter medications (ie. Aspirin, cough syrup, etc.)
- Formal wear - for Charity Ball in February
- Plastic basket or caddy for carrying toiletry items to and from the shower
- Laundry basket, detergent, fabric softener sheets and quarters
- Clothes hangers
- Hair dryer, curling iron, hot rollers, etc
- Sewing kit
- Umbrella and raincoat
- Small sports equipment and gear
- Toiletry items (shampoo, toothpaste, towels, soap, shower flip flops etc.)
- Radio/CD player and headphones...and of course, CDs, and iPod/Mp3 player
- Phone
- Battery operated radio (and extra batteries!)
- Closet organizer
- Long Distance calling card/call me card
- Small TV and DVD player
- Fan
- Snacks (and dishes to eat them on)
- Winter clothing

What should I leave home?*

- Candles/ incense
- Mini-fridge (if you are in Assisi and unless you have a doctor's note)
- Small Appliances
- Masking tape
- Halogen lamps
- Pets (only fish in bowls are allowed)
- Phone splitters or extension cords
- Window coverings (curtains are permanently fixed to windows)
- Hammer/Nails
- Subwoofers/speakers larger than 6"
- Soft furniture
- Mattresses
- Weapons and firearms
- Electrical kitchen appliances (prohibited in traditional rooms- this includes hot plates with elements of any kind and gas burning devices.)
- Real Christmas trees
- Rugs/Carpets
- Amplified musical instruments/drums

**This list is the same for all residence areas!*



Apartments!

What is provided in an apartment style residence?

Bedroom:



- Captain's bed - with 3 drawers
- Night table
- Desk with hutch
- Desk chair
- Armoire closet with shelves and drawers
- Full –length mirror

Kitchen:



- Fridge
- Microwave
- Toaster
- Kettle
- Stove
- Iron & ironing board
- Garbage Can

Living Room:



- Sofa & chair
- Coffee table & end table
- Lamps
- TV stand with colour TV and cable
- Kitchen table & 4 chairs

Attention Apartment Students!

In addition to the previous list for traditional students, apartment students should also bring:

- Garbage/Recycling bags
- Broom and dustpan
- Paper towel, facial & toilet tissue
- Cleaning Supplies
- Food
- Pots & Pans
- Dishes & cutlery
- Small appliances (such as, sandwich maker, coffeemaker etc.)
- Bedside lamp
- DVD Player
- Mattress cover (optional, mattresses are treated with a protective coating)
- Apartments are allowed to have small appliances however; they are not permitted to have a deep fat fryer anywhere in the apartment!
- Kitchenware (dish towels, mixing bowls, measuring cups, cutting board, etc.)
