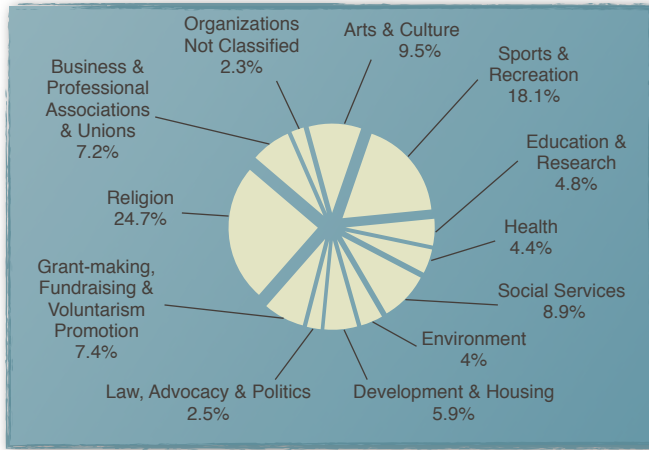

There are **2,219** non-profit organizations in NL – About 17% of the **12,882** non-profit organizations serving the Atlantic region

In NL 57% of the non-profit organizations are registered charities

Revenues of non-profit and voluntary organizations in 2003 = \$1,006,000,000

Types of NL Non-Profit Organizations



Human resources in the non-profit and voluntary sector:

29,614 Newfoundlanders & Labradorians are employed in the sector - About 28% of the workers employed in the Atlantic region

NL has **197,000** volunteers - About 20% of the volunteers in the Atlantic region

However, the number of average volunteer hours decreased from 188 hours in 2004 to 176 hours in 2007

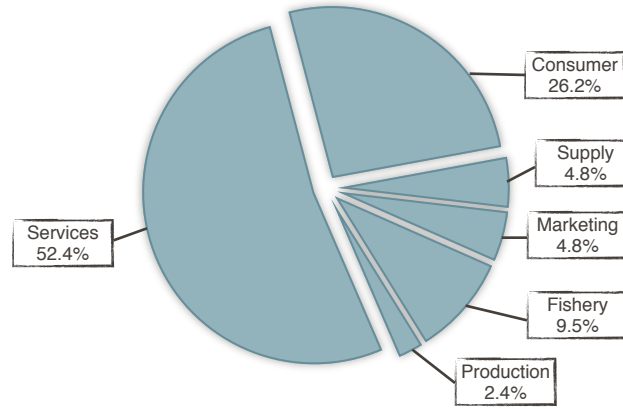
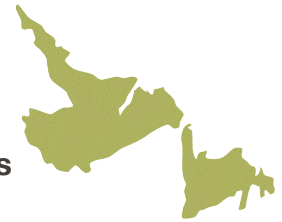

In Newfoundland and Labrador there are **63** co-operatives and **13** credit unions

Types of NL Non-financial Co-operatives



2005

Co-operatives had 45,000 memberships and 1,120 employees

Total sales revenues = \$124 million
Total assets = \$58.1 million

The average number of years in business for both non-financial co-ops & credit unions is 34 years

For credits unions and the average is 35 years

For non-financial co-ops the average is 34 years

2008

NL Credit Unions

Total assets = \$632+ million
Total revenues = \$41 million

Memberships = 51,000
Employees = 312
