### Project Description:

The Trout River Environmental Committee Inc. wishes to complete a survey designed to gather information about watershed residents' perceptions of quality of life within the watershed, the level environmental awareness in individuals, and the individual's awareness of the connection between quality of life and environmental health.

To do this, TREC would like to partner with the Institute of Island Studies and the Quality of Island Life Co-op to complete a project similar in scope and scale to the recent Tyne Valley and Lennox Island studies (SN 2.2). This project would be specifically designed to dovetail with these previous projects, would contribute to the larger overall goal of contributing to the development of a Community Accounts project in PEI, and would aid TREC and watershed residents alike by enabling better watershed planning at the community level.
