Step-by-Step Participation Guide

Self-enroll in the LP Moodle Site.

Any student can earn LP bonus points who are taking eligible Business & Tourism course(s).

All students can participate for learning purposes.

Complete the photo release consent agreement to gain full access to the LP Moodle site.

Read and understand the rules.

Avoid missing out on activity points or loosing the privilege to participate by failing to follow the rules.

Step-by-Step Participation Guide

Plan your activities around your schedule.

There's lots to choose from.

Remember: Don't miss a class to attend.

Attend the entire activity; arriving late or departing early won't earn you the activity point.

Ensure LP can verify your attendance: Sign the attendance sheet or login using your own Mount email.

Complete and submit the survey related to the activity within 48 hours.

The survey will close after this time period.

It's crucial to submit surveys only for the activities you attend.

Step-by-Step Participation Guide

Receive an activity point.

View 'Grades' section on the LP Moodle site to view your activity points earned. Any concerns & questions about your activity points must be received by LP before Reading Day.

On Reading Day, your professors in all LP eligible business and tourism courses will be provided with your earned bonus points.




