- letter of application (250-500 words) outlining the reasons for applying and the suitability of the applicant for this scholarship, reflecting on the significance of community activism or engagement for the applicant, which may include, for example, a discussion of the applicant's relevant academic work, of the Mount's feminist and social justice mission, or of the applicant's past, present, and/or potential future community activism or engagement activities
- resume/CV (1-2 pages)
- documentary evidence of their past or current participation in or potential for future participation in community activism or engagement, including a letter of support by at least one referee from a place of employment, volunteer site, or professor, addressing how the applicant is community-minded

In drafting their applications, applicants are encouraged to make use of campus supports such the Writing Centre and the Centre for Academic Advising and Student Success, as well as seeking advice from professors.
