



MSVU 20 MONTH BACHELOR OF EDUCATION PROGRAM

- Applications open in October and close in December. The application page can be found [here](#).
- You can gain conditional acceptance into the program for prerequisites that are in progress or up to a maximum of 1.5 credits in missing prerequisites.
- Both secondary (7-12) and elementary (P-6) streams
- There is information about prerequisites for elementary and secondary streams linked to this page.
- The BEd is a 60-credit hour program, and all courses are in person on campus (**there are currently no part time or online course options**).
- If accepted, the program takes place over the fall and winter semesters of both the first and second years.
- You must complete a Practicum in public schools
- The Practicum in first year involves a week in November and a 5-week period from mid-April to mid-May.
- All Practica in the first year are in the Halifax region.
- The Practicum in the second year involves a week in early September, a week in November and a 14-week period from January to mid-April.
- In the second year, there are possibilities of a Practicum outside the Halifax Region.
- We also offer the possibility of a Community Placement in the last four weeks of your Practicum in the second year.
- Upon successful completion of the BEd program and fulfillment of regulatory requirements you will be certified to teach in Nova Scotia public schools.
