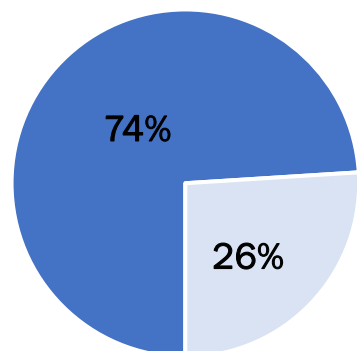

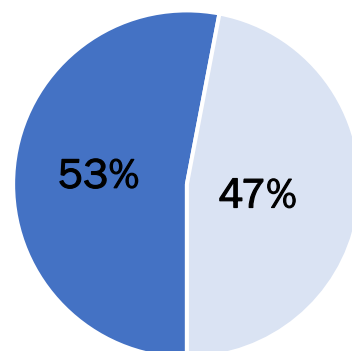

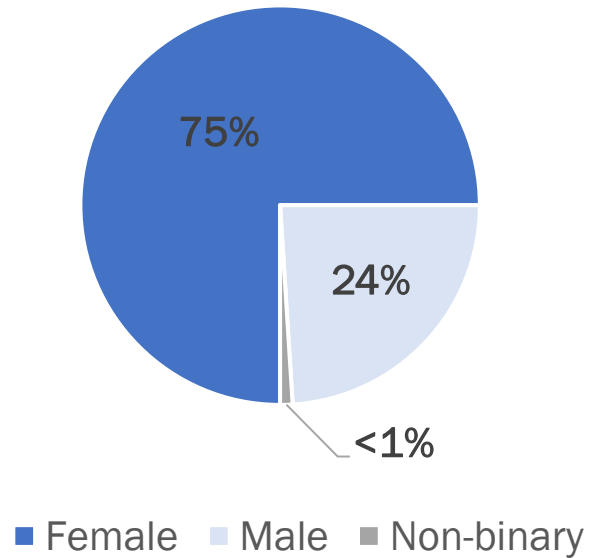


# DEMOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN

Gender



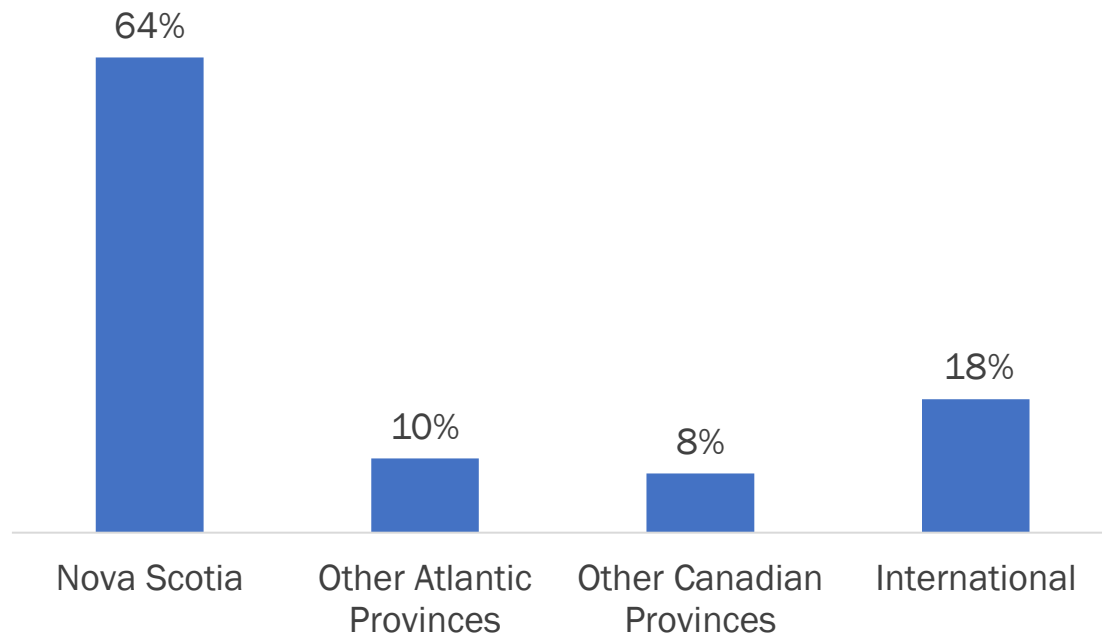
Age Distribution

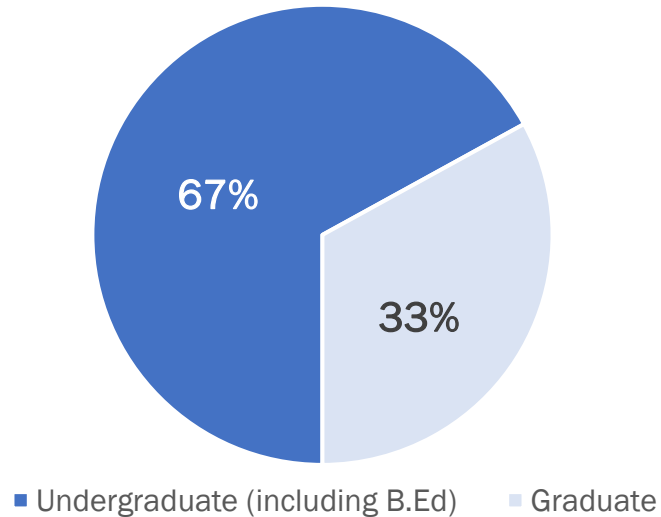
