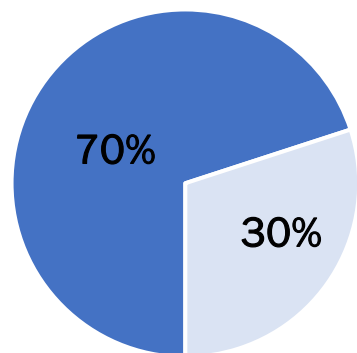

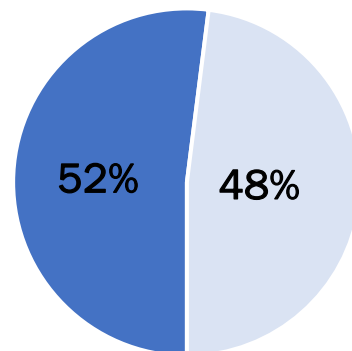

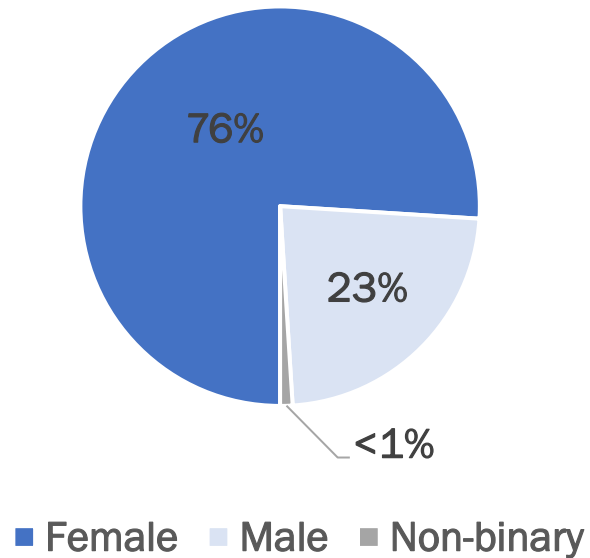


DEMOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN

Gender



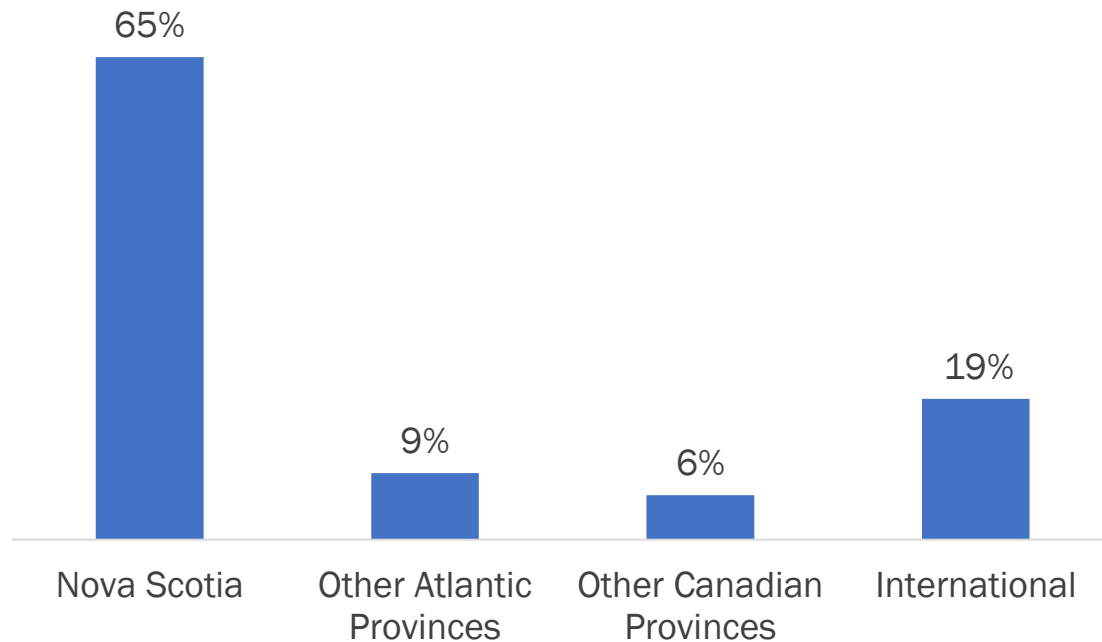

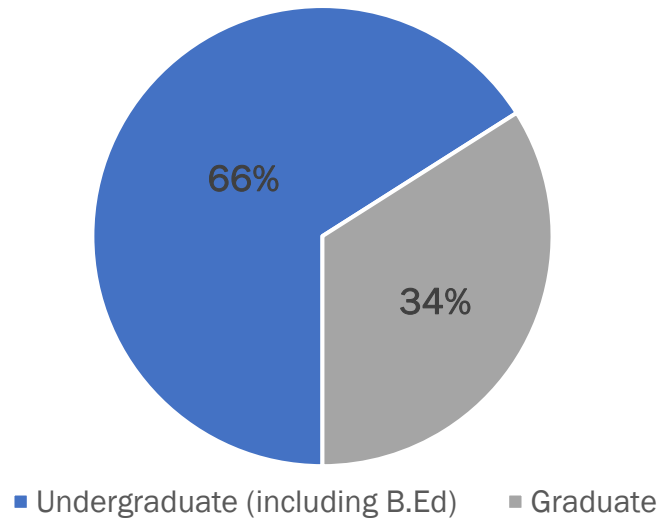
