PAYMENT OPTIONS

PAY IN FULL

- Pay the total camp fee(s) at the time of registration, including a 10% non-refundable deposit.
- You can add multiple camps to your cart and pay at the end. Each camp must be added individually, but can be processed with one payment.
- Credit Card (Visa, Mastercard, AMEX), Debit, Cash
- Please note: debit and cash are only available in-person

PAYMENT PLANS

- Pay 10% now and the remainder at a later date.
- If the payment plan option is selected, a non-refundable deposit (10% of the total camp fee) is paid upfront and the remainder of the camp fee will be processed one week prior to the start of the camp.
- Each camp registration is done separately. You must add one camp to the cart and complete the payment. Then repeat the process for each additional camp.
- Credit Card (Visa, Mastercard, AMEX) only.

NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT

- Each camp registration requires a 10% non-refundable deposit, per week.
- The non-refundable deposit is included in the overall camp fee.

REFUND POLICY

To cancel your camp registration and receive a refund (minus the NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT - see details above) you must:

- Request to withdraw in writing by emailing camps@msvu.ca
- Submit request THREE WEEKS prior to the day or week of camp that you are requesting to withdraw from.
- If requesting within the three-week period, a refund will only be issued if a replacement can be found. Exception: Medical reason with supporting documentation.

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 Refunds will be processed within 2-3 weeks of initial request.

Inclusion Support Information

We welcome children of all abilities in our summer camp programs and offer inclusive programming for campers requiring extra support due to a physical, medical, behavioral and/or developmental exceptionality. Campers will receive one-on-one support from an Inclusion Leader who will work directly with the camper, making every effort to include campers in adapted activities, and ensuring their overall safety and happiness while in our care. We do our best to accommodate all participants' needs, but please understand that some needs may be beyond our scope of accommodation.

Please note that by not disclosing the needs of a participant prior to registration, we may be required to withdraw the participant from the program until appropriate supports can be put into place or become available.

When assessing whether a One-to-One Inclusion Support Person is required, please consider the following:

- Is extra support required at school and/or in the community?
- Is extra help required at home for basic care?
- Is there an existing physical, medical, behavioral and/or developmental disability that could affect the safety and enjoyment of the participant and/or other participants?

Our Inclusion Staff will:

- Provide 1:1 support during regular camp hours
 7:30 a.m. 5:30 p.m.
- Swim trip one day per week with your child. Swim trips take place from Week #3 to Week #8.
- Make accommodations and adaptations specific to your child's needs to ensure they are fully included in our summer day camp program.
- Request daily communication check-ins from your parents.
- Report end of day feedback to parents.

What support MSVU day camps cannot offer:

MSVU day camp staff are not qualified to carry out procedures such as catheterization, tube feeding or assisted feeding, suctioning, injections, and/or managing aggressive behaviours. In these cases, we require families to make alternative arrangements. Any medications that are required must be taken independently by the children under the supervision of an inclusion staff member. Proof of prescription and written authorization are required.

- Inclusion support is available in all of our camps, with limited spots available each week, based on a first-come, first-served registration process.

- In the month of May our Inclusion Coordinator will reach out to all registered families for additional information to help us best accommodate each individual camper's needs.

SWIM TRIP

- Swim trips take place from Week #3 to Week #8.
- Each child will swim once per week.
- We travel on Metro Transit to our swim location.
- There are no additional fees for swim trip.
- If you would like to request a specific trip day for your camper, please inform the staff at drop-off on the Monday of each week.

DROP-OFF PROCEDURE

- Parents/Guardians are required to escort their child to the Gymnasium, Rosaria Student Centre (main floor).
- Parents/Guardians must check-in their child at the gym entrance. DO NOT drop your child off at the front doors. If another person is picking up your child, please inform staff upon check-in.
- Doors open at 7:30 a.m. with supervised free play until 9:00 a.m. Structured programming will begin at 9:00 a.m.
- DO NOT LEAVE MEDICATIONS WITH YOUR CHILD. If your child needs to take medication, please give it to the day camp staff member at the check-in table.
- Please ensure that your camper arrives with outdoor clothing as we will be spending time outdoors, weather permitting.

PICK-UP PROCEDURE

- PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED DURING THE SIGN-OUT PROCESS.
 - For safety reasons day camp staff are required to verify identification before releasing the child to an authorized pick-up person.
- Children must be signed out by a parent/guardian or a person on the authorized pick-up list.
- Structured camp activities will end at 4:00 p.m.
 Supervised free play continues until 5:30 p.m. in the gymnasium.
- There is a late fee of \$5 for each additional 15 minutes a child remains after 5:30 p.m.
- If you will be picking up your child during 9-4 p.m. camp time, it is advised that your inquire at the Mount Fitness Centre (902-457-6420), as campers may be in a different room or outside.

ALLERGIES & MEDICATIONS

- DO NOT LEAVE MEDICATIONS WITH YOUR CHILD.
- Please inform the MSVU Day Camp Staff of all allergies and/or medications.
- If your child needs to take medication, please give it to the day camp staff member upon sign in.
- Medications must be prescribed to the camper by a physician and be in the original packaging. Proof of prescription and written authorization are required.
- Over the counter medications will not be administered.



ALLERGY ALERT

We will do lunch checks every morning at drop-off.

- All lunches and snacks must be 100% NUT FREE!
- We may add additional food restrictions week to week based on the allergies and severity of allergic reactions of our campers that week.

DISCIPLINARY CODE

- The MSVU Day Camp Program has established a three-step disciplinary code to assist the staff in dealing with behavioural problems, if and when necessary. These procedures are designed to provide a fun and safe atmosphere for all participants.
 - Step one includes speaking to child and parent/guardian.
 - Step two includes speaking to child and parent/guardian, in addition to disciplinary action of some form that day (i.e. sitting out of a camp activity).
 - Step three includes speaking to child and parent/guardian, disciplinary action, and the possible dismissal of the child from camp if proper behavior is not forthcoming.
- The MSVU Day Camp Program aims to prevent bullying, hitting, swearing and/or name calling within our camp through positive reinforcement and peer reconciliation.
