## **Important Notes**

If you wish to do an honours degree, you must apply in writing to the department chair. Application may be made after the completion of 10.0 units of study. See the Undergraduate Academic Calendar for more information.

Within your course work, you must complete a minimum of 1.0 unit from each of the following groups, exclusive of your honours subject:

A: Sciences and Mathematics NUTR (science minor), Applied Statistics (see MATH), BIOL, CHEM, CMPS, MATH, PHYS, PSYC\*

**B: Social Sciences** 

CANA. COMM. ECON. FSGN. POLS.PSYC\*. SOAN. WOMS

C: Humanities (Not including ENGL) CHIN, CULS, FREN, HIST, LIBR, PHIL, RELS, SPAN. WRIT

PSYC may count towards Group A or B, but not both.

You may count up to 4.0 units of professional study towards your degree. Professional study subjects include:

BUSI, CHYS\*, INTE, NUTR (acceptable courses under professional minor in Academic Calendar), PBRL, THMT \*Practica may not be counted for credit towards the degree (i.e. CHYS 2251, 3351, 3352, 4451)

You may take up to an additional 2.0 units of ENGL as general electives.

Up to half of your honours, minor, and overall credit requirements may be met via transfer credit (including Letter of Permission (LOP) courses). Courses with a "P" grade are GPA neutral.

You must obtain a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a grade of Cin at least 10.0 units of required honours courses.

You must obtain a minimum of B- in the honours thesis.

You must obtain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in your minor.

You must obtain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above in all courses counted for the degree beyond the first 5.0 units.

First-class honours will be awarded to students who maintain a GPA of 3.5 or above in 10.0 units in the honours subject and no grade below a B- in all courses counted for the degree beyond the first 5.0 units taken.

You are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount; however, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
