### Important notes

You must apply to the Department by February 1 for entrance to the honours program.

You must apply to the Registrar's office to change your degree program to honours once you receive confirmation from the SOAN Chair that you have been accepted into the Honours program.

Within your course work, you must complete a minimum of one unit of each of the following groups:

**A: Sciences and Mathematics**

NUTR (science minor), Applied Statistics (see MATH), BIOL, CHEM, CMPS, MATH, PHYS, PSYC\*  
*MATH 2208 & 2209 are recommended.*

**B: Social Sciences (not including SOAN)**

CANA, COMM, ECON, FSGN, POLS, PSYC\*, WOMS

**C: Humanities**

CHIN, CULS, ENGL, FREN, HIST, LIBR, PHIL, RELS, SPAN, WRIT

\*PSYC may count towards Group A or B, but not both.

You may count up to four units of professional study towards your major. Professional study subjects include:

BUSI, CHYS\*, INTE, NUTR (professional minor), PBRL, THMT

\*Practica may not be counted for credit towards the degree (i.e. CHYS 2251, 3351, 3352, 4451)

You may take up to an additional 2.0 units of SOAN as general electives, if you wish.

Students may count a maximum of 4.0 units of directed/independent/research studies courses towards the degree, with no more than 2.0 units in any single discipline.

A minimum of 9.5 units of your degree must be at the 2000 level or above. Of the 9.5, at least 3.5 units of SOAN at the 2000 level (SOAN 2500 and 2.0 units of electives) and 6.0 units of SOAN at the 3000 level or above (SOAN 3501, 3511, 3512, 4590, 4599 and 3.0 units SOAN electives) are required.

Up to half of your major, minor, and overall credit requirements may be met via transfer credit (including Authorized External Courses). Courses with a "P" grade are GPA neutral.

Your GPA in SOAN and your overall GPA must be  $\geq 3.0$ .  
Your GPA for your minor must be  $\geq 2.0$ . See the academic calendar for more information.

You are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount. However, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
