## Important notes

You must declare your major before registering for your sixth unit of course work. See the Registrar's Office or the departmental administrative assistant for the required form.

Admission to honours is granted by permission of the department. Applications are due on the first Friday in February. Applications can be obtained from the departmental administrative assistant.

Within your course work, you must complete a minimum of one unit of each of the following groups:

- A: Sciences and Mathematics MATH 2208 & 2209 fulfill this requirement.
- B: Social Sciences (not including PSYC) CANA, COMM, ECON, FSGN, POLS, SOAN, WOMS
- C: Humanities ENGL/WRIT fulfill this requirement.

You may count up to four units of professional study towards your degree. Professional study subjects include:

- BUSI, CHYS\*, INTE, NUTR (professional minor), PBRL, THMT
- \*Practica may not be counted for credit towards the degree (i.e. CHYS 2251, 3351, 3352, 4451)

You may take up to an additional 2.0 units of PSYC as general electives, if you wish.

Students may count a maximum of 4.0 units of directed/independent/research studies courses towards the degree, with no more than 2.0 units in any single discipline.

A minimum of 9.0 units of your degree must be at the 2000 level or above.

Up to half of your major, minor and overall credit requirements may be met via transfer credit (including Letter of Permission Courses). Courses with a "P' grade are GPA neutral.

Your GPA in your honours subject must be ≥ 3.0, with no grade below C-. Your overall GPA must be ≥ 3.0, after your first 5.0 units. Your minor GPA must be  $\geq$  2.0. See the academic calendar for more information.

If your minor requires courses that are also required under the Psychology major, you will need to take an equivalent number of extra electives to ensure completion of 20 units of coursework

You are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount. However, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
