Important Notes

Students wishing to obtain an honours degree must make formal application to the department Chair by May 1 of the third year or after completing 15.0 units

Academic Advising: All CHYS students must seek academic advising once admitted to the program. Contact advising@msvu.ca or drop by the Centre for Academic Advising and Student Success in Seton 303.

GPA: Minimum requirements for acceptance into the honours degree are a GPA of 3.0 in 10.0 units of the required academic units listed in the first three years of the program with a grade of at least C- in each of these units. Students much achieve at least a B- in CHYS 3311 and CHYS 4499

Minor: Students may complete a 3.0 unit minor by fulfilling the requirements for the minor as specified by the department offering the minor. Students must achieve a 2.0 GPA in the required 3.0 units.

Practicum: CHYS students are required to successfully complete 2.0 units of supervised practicum, at least 0.5 unit of which must be completed under CHYS department supervision.

These practica are completed in a variety of community-based programs and services for children, youth, and families and are completed two days per week (830-430) during the fall and winter, or as four-week block placements (Monday-Friday) in Summer Sessions I & II. Students may not enroll in daytime courses during practica days. Before any placement, students must meet the following prerequisites:

- a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher at the end of the academic term prior to the practicum experience.
- completion of all prerequisites for the practicum for which they intend to register.

Students who do not complete any practicum successfully will not be permitted to continue in the program.

Child Abuse Register, Vulnerable Sector Check and First Aid Certification: Students are required to produce the following documents on the first day of each of their practica: Child Abuse Registry letter, Vulnerable Sector Check, and Emergency First Aid & CPR "C"/AED certificate. Go to msvu.ca/practicumdocs for more information on obtaining the required documentation. In accordance with government of Nova Scotia requirements, students who do not produce the required documentation will not be permitted to proceed with the practicum.

While you are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
