- Moodle: the web platform for online classes and most in-person ones too!
- A place to submit assignments, take quizzes/tests, access Blackboard Collaborate (your online classroom), and review course materials such as slide shows and lecture notes
- Where you'll find Mount101!;)



Moodle - Log in

- Visit learn.msvu.ca and log-in using your MyMount credentials
 - Or msvu.ca and click "Moodle"
- Sign-in in advance to be sure your password is correct
 - If you have any trouble, contact helpdesk@msvu.ca












Classes on Moodle

- A device with a working speaker and microphone is a must




Class etiquette

1. Click on the puzzle piece as if you're joining your class.






Troubleshooting Tips

- Log-on early in case there are problems
 Classes generally start on time, and often with announcements
- Try logging out and logging back in
- Check audio settings in Collaborate if you can't hear
- Let your professor know if you're having trouble joining
- Move locations, turn off your camera, and close tabs
- If all else fails, get help!






