Students who plan on taking MATH 1102, MATH 1113 and MATH 2500 (Pre-Calculus I, Calculus I, Stats Models and Data Analysis) must take a math placement test prior to registration. The following exceptions apply:

- If you have completed MATH 0027 (or a verified transfer credit equivalent) with a grade of C in the last 3 years you are able to register in MATH 1102 without taking the placement test.
- If you have completed MATH 1103 (or a verified transfer credit equivalent) you are able to register in MATH 1113 without taking the placement test.
