



When is my payment due?

Payment Due Dates are found in your myMount account under the Money Matters tile or at msvu.ca/tuition.

Students must pay the required fee instalment by each term's payment deadlines (listed below) in order to complete their registration and keep their course selections for that term.

Winter 2026 Term – Payment is due January 14, 2026

There are financial penalties applied to accounts not paid in full by the deadlines each term.

Withdrawal from Classes:

- January 14th, 2026 - last date to drop Winter 2026 courses without academic or financial penalty
- Refund Schedule Applies after January 14th with declining pro-rated refund
- If you decide not to attend or visa not approved, make sure you drop your courses by January 14th, 2026 to avoid financial penalties

January 29 to February 4	0%	30%
After February 4	0%	0%

What are my payment options?

Payment Options:

Electronic payment preferred:

- Within Canada – bill payment option through online banking (app or browser) – your 7-digit student ID number is the account number
 - Processing: 2-3 days
- International payments – preferred option Convera for students (formerly Global Pay for Students) – also have bank wire option
 - Processing: 7-9 days

Credit cards are not accepted for tuition and residence payments

- International debit cards are not accepted at the Financial Services counters

Government Student Loans

National Student Loans
Service Centre (NSLSC)



- We begin processing loan files in mid-December and work to have all files processed by the payment deadline.
- Ensure you are registered full-time (3 academic courses or 2 academic courses for students with a registered disability)
- MSVU confirms your enrolment, program and tuition and indicates tuition fees to be paid to University, any remaining funds are sent to the student's bank account
- We will send an email to you if your loan is not sufficient to cover fees
- 5 to 7 days for funding to be received (monitor myPath for NS)

Student Loan Agreement Form

- If there is a delay with your student loan, please complete Student Loan Agreement Form at www.msvu.ca/tuition
- Gives extension until end of January for loan to be received
- Interest/late fees still apply after January 14th, 2025
- Stay on top of the status of your loan and address any outstanding items promptly

Other Student Related Fees

International Student Medical:



- International students beginning studies in Winter 2026 are automatically charged - \$440.25 which covers students from January 1, 2026 to August 31, 2026.
- You cannot opt out from Guard.me based on other types of insurance you may purchase
- You will receive welcome letters January with your policy #
- Access your card through www.guard.me/msvu once you receive welcome letter
- You can add and pay for dependent's coverage through Guard.me website once you have policy #
- If policy information is needed sooner, email financial.services@msvu.ca

International Student Medical Opt-Outs:

There are only two options for students to opt-out of the international student medical insurance coverage:

1. If you are taking courses from out of country
 - Complete opt out form no later than January 14, 2026
2. If you are covered under MSI (Nova Scotia Medical Services Insurance)
 - Complete opt-out form by January 14, 2026
 - Effective date on card must be January 1, 2026 or earlier
 - If the expiry date on card is before Aug 31, 2026 will need to send copy of replacement card before expiry



Student Union Medical and Dental Plan



- Full-time domestic students beginning studies in January will not automatically be charged for the Student Union Health & Dental Plan.
- Students can email patti.gentile@msvu.ca if they wish to be enrolled in the insurance plan.
- The Student Union Medical plan is \$352.06 and the Dental Plan charge is \$202.23 for full-time students from January 1st to August 31st 2026.
- Part-time students can opt-in to the plan by emailing patti.gentile@msvu.ca. The part-time student fee is \$823.69.

Welcome to your student health and dental benefits plan!

This is available to all eligible domestic students here at Mount Saint Vincent University. The benefit plan portal offers a variety of services and is designed to be user and mobile-friendly. It provides an online single-point-of-contact to access your current information and manage your benefits. It even has a digital copy of your Benefit card!

We are pleased to offer you all the services you need on the website. We have been working with many dental offices, pharmacies and health practitioners in your area to ensure that they offer direct billing so you pay less out of pocket.

Some of the services found on our portal include:

Claim Submission - allows you to submit claims and receive payment confirmation. If you use a provider that offers direct billing, you won't need to do this!

Benefit Cards - pay-direct benefits are available online and can be saved to your smartphone for easy access. Just show this card to the front desk to see if your provider will direct bill.

Direct Deposit - add or update your banking information for quick reimbursement.

Download Centre - view or print a copy of the benefit booklet, brochures, and forms.

UPASS Program:

The U-Pass is a sticker you add to your student ID card, which provides unlimited bus and ferry service in the HRM.

Instead of buying bus tickets or monthly passes, full-time students can use the U-Pass.

UPASS Program

- ❑ All graduate and undergraduate students who are registered full-time at MSVU in the term for which the U-Pass is being issued, will receive a U-Pass.
- ❑ Great value – a bus pass purchased through Halifax Transit is \$90/month
- ❑ Pick up your ID Card from the Library
- ❑ Once you have your ID card, go to Financial Services in Evaristus Hall to get the U-PASS sticker if eligible
- ❑ Students can only opt out if they are 100% in online courses or on a co-op work term outside of Halifax Regional Municipality
