Who Can Apply

A student enrolled in final semester of the Mount Saint Vincent University Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality Management Degree Program or Tourism and Hospitality Management Diploma Program or recently graduated in 2019 from either program.

Applicant must not have received any other Canadian Hospitality Foundation scholarship. Applicant must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.

How to Apply

Submit the completed form along with the following documents to the Awards Officer/Scholarship Coordinator or your Professor:

- completed and signed application form (pen, typewritten or printed copy of filled in form only)
- resume or curriculum vitae
- OFFICIAL copy of transcript of records of current or recent program
- two (2) letters of recommendation from a current faculty member and/or school administrator
 - *Each letter must be signed and must include address, telephone and email address and be on school letterhead*
- two (2) letters of recommendation from a past or present employers or volunteer managers
 - *Each letter must be signed and must include address, telephone and email address and be on company letterhead*

Please remind your reference providers that they need to describe their personal knowledge of your performance, your leadership skills and other particular skills along with the time and activity that you provided (form reference letters will not be accepted)

Applications with missing, falsified or incomplete documents will not be considered.

Criteria

Applications will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Work experience: 25 points
 - based on quality and length of work experience with extra points for foodservice, hospitality, and culinary-related experience and for increased levels of responsibility
2. Leadership and ability to get along with others: 25 points
 - based on work experience, letters of reference and responses to application questions
3. Education record: 10 points
 - based on grade point average
4. Professional promise: 20 points
 - based on work experience, letters of reference and responses to application questions
5. Extra-Curricular / Volunteer Activities: 20 points
 - based on participation and enthusiasm with extra points for industry-related events and activities and for increased levels of responsibility

Deadline for Submission

Please kindly check with your school for deadline date.

Payment of Scholarship Money

The scholarship money will be paid to the school in its entirety in the year the scholarship is awarded. The Foundation will seek confirmation of full-time enrollment or graduation from your school before payment is made. Payment is credited towards the recipient's tuition fees. If the tuition fee has already been paid in full or partially, the full or remaining money will then be paid to the student by the school. Tax document will be provided by your school. The full amount of your award must be declared on your tax return.
