



Important Notes

You must declare your major before registering for your 6th unit of course work. See the Registrar's Office or the departmental administrative assistant for the required form.

Within your course work, you must complete a minimum of 1.0 unit from each of the following groups, exclusive of your Major subject:

A: Sciences and Mathematics
NUTR (science minor), Applied Statistics (see MATH), BIOL, CHEM, CMPS, MATH, PHYS, PSYC*

B: Social Sciences (not including CANA)
COMM, ECON, FSGN, POLS, PSYC*, SOAN, WOMS

C: Humanities
CHIN, CULS, ENGL, FREN, HIST, LIBR, PHIL, RELS, SPAN, WRIT

*PSYC may count towards Group A or B, but not both.

You may count up to 4.0 units of professional study towards your degree. Professional study subjects include:

BUSI, CHYS*, INTE, NUTR (acceptable courses under professional minor in Academic Calendar), PBRL, THMT

*Practica may not be counted for credit towards the degree (i.e. CHYS 2251, 3351, 3352, 4451)

You may take up to an additional 2.0 units of CANA as general electives.

Students with no background in Canadian History or the French language are advised to take a 1000 level course in those subjects along with the other Canadian Studies courses. This is not a requirement.

Students may count a maximum of 2.0 units of directed/independent/research studies courses towards the degree.

A minimum of 9.0 units of your degree must be at the 2000 level or above.

Up to half of your major, minor, and overall credit requirements may be met via transfer credit (including Letter of Permission (LOP) Courses). Courses with a "P" grade are GPA neutral.

Your GPA in your major and minor must be a 2.0 or above. Your overall GPA must be a 1.7 or above. See the academic calendar for more information.

You are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount; however, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
