- ◆ Grade 12 English with a minimum grade of 65%
- ◆ Grade 11 academic math
- ◆ 4 additional grade 12 academic courses with a minimum grade of 60% and an overall average of 70% (students with an average of 65-69% are considered on a case-by-case basis).
