Regulating the Body: Social and Individual

DRUGS: Humans live in societies according to explicit rules and implicit, internalized guidelines. Our bodies are physically regulated, through what we wear, where we are allowed to go, what we are allowed—or required—to consume.

Explore how the substances we consume and the regulations and proscriptions around those substances shape our individual and social lives. *Who/what has the power to make those decisions?*

Investigate: steroids/athletic culture; “social drugs (licit and illicit); prescribed drugs (the opioid crisis, Big Pharma); food additives; gendered drug use; drugs and culture (music, film), and more.
