- GPA of 2.0** in units counted for Major

- Minimum of 6 and maximum of 8 full units in second major field from one of:**

- Minor of 3 full units or area of concentration**

- 15 full units** after Grade XII (or equivalent)

- minimum of 6 and maximum of 8 full units** in each Major field

- at least 9 full units at 2000 level or above** of all courses required for the degree

- at least 5 full units at 3000 level or above** of the 12 overall for the combined major

- no more than 4 full units of credit from professional areas**

- maximum of 3 full units of directed/independent/research studies courses with no more than 2 full units in any single discipline**

- required:** one full unit from each of (inclusive of the majors)
