The “Expand your world program” is a MODL program meant to encourage students to extend learning outside their courses and classrooms by participating in activities and events related to the language they study. Activities in French, Spanish and Chinese such as movies, festivals, plays, conferences, music shows, guided tours of sites, etc. are organized regularly in the HRM area, whether by the MODL Department (the French Club or the Spanish Club, for example), the Alliance française, the Conseil Communautaire du Grand-Havre, or the Hispanic and Asian communities. Any student enrolled in a course within the MODL Department may earn up to 2 bonus points per semester in the course of his/her choice if he/she participates in such activities. To obtain credit, the student must have the professor’s prior approval, and either give a short presentation about the event to the class or submit a short report to his/her professor. Ask your professor for details!

Details

- . Students can earn up to a total of 2 bonus points per semester;
- . 0,5 or 1 bonus point is granted for each activity, depending of the value of the activity (at the professor’s discretion);
- . Students may choose for which course the bonus will apply (only one course can be chosen);
- . Students must ask for the approval of the professor who teaches the course before the activity takes place;
- . Students must give a short presentation in class OR submit a short report to their professor once the activity is completed;
- . Please note that this program may not apply to all courses; it is conditional on the approval of each professor.
