Finally, I wish to express my thanks to the support of the community partners throughout this process. I know how difficult this has been for all, and for those of you remaining in the project, I sincerely wish you the greatest success in realizing the hopes we had at the outset. For the Bay of Fundy Marine Resource Centre and for the Fundy Fixed Gear Council, who have also withdrawn from this project, I am confident that they will find other means to develop their social research capacity.
