

Kitchen

- Dishes, cups & utensils
- Food storage containers
- Pots & Pans
- Cutlery & Cooking Utensils

- Pizza cutter

Cleaning

- Broom & dust pan
- Surface cleaner (lysol wipes, toilet cleaner, stove cleaner, etc.)
- Sponge/dish clothes
- Dish soap
- Toilet brush

Bathroom (One for 2 Bedroom two for 4 Bedroom)

- Shower curtain, rings, and liner
- Toilet paper & paper towel
- Hair dryer
- Handsoap

Before you arrive, you can request to know who your roommates are to help plan who brings what items, and if you will be sharing.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Stereo speaker over 6 in & sub-woofers
- Electrical kitchen appliances (small appliances are permitted in apartments)
- Candles - prohibited in residence
- Window covering
- Phone splitters
- Masking tape
- Real Christmas tress
- Extension cords
- Pets (fish in bowls are permitted)
- Weapons & firearms



If the above items are found in your residence room, you will be given a fine. Please use common sense when bringing items into residence. If you are unsure if it will be allowed, please contact the Residence Life Office.


Decorating your room!

- Please ensure that there is nothing attached to, or covering sprinklers. Heaters are not to be covered or have items placed on/near them. Mini lights are the only decorative lighting permitted.
- The bulletin boards on your door and in your room, are there for you to use! Please try to keep it in good condition (not ripped), and use only push pin on the board.
- When putting up decorations in the room students are only permitted to use 3M tape, or sticky tack, and push pins. All damage, such as peeled paint, will result in a fine.

Laundry Services

- Washer and dryers are \$1 each, loonies only
- Assisi laundry room is on the second floor (5 washers and 5 dryers)
- The birches have a laundry room on the first floor (1 washer and 1 dryer for each birch)
- Westwood has a laundry room on each floor (2 washers and 2 dryers)
- Please be respectful to other students and their laundry.







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Residence Rumble: Move-In Day

September 2nd at 10 AM

- All students can start to move in!
- Pick up your Residence keys
- Move into your new home at the Mount
- You can also:
- Pick up your pre-ordered Orientation kit
- Get registered for Shinerama
- Meet your Orientation group and leaders

After 12 PM on September 2nd

- Pick up your keys at the Assisi front desk.
- If you are planning on a late arrival (after September 10th), you must email the Residence Life office before move-in day.

After September 10th

Students who do not show and have:

- Confirmed room by signed lease and room deposit, and
- Did not contact the office to confirm a late move-in

will be automatically withdrawn from residence, and their deposit will be absorbed by the University.

Getting to the Mount

By Car:

From New Brunswick/CapeBreton

- Follow the Trans-Canada (Nova Scotia Highway 104)
- **Take exit #15 to get to Highway 102 South** (Only exit to Halifax)
- Stay on Highway 102 until exit #2
- **Take exit #2 for Kearney Lake**
- Turn Left onto Kearney Lake Rd
- Turn Right onto Bedford Highway/Nova Scotia Trunk 2 South
- Drive for approx 5 mins
- **Turn right onto Seton Rd**

From West (Wolfville)

- **Follow Highway 101 East**
- **Take exit #2**
- Follow the above directions from exit #2.

From South (Bridgewater)

- **Follow Highway 103 East**
- Take **exit #0** to Joseph Howe Dr
- Turn left onto **Joseph Howe Dr**
- Follow signs to **NS Trunk 2 North/Bedford**
- **Turn left onto Seton Rd.**

From the Airport:

- Follow the signs directing you to Highway 102 South and Halifax
- Follow the 102 as stated above, **use exit #2**







Weswood and the Birches






STEP 5: START UNPACKING

MSVU WiFi

The wifi network you want to connect to is called “Mount WiFi”. The log-in information is your MSVU username and password. If you’re having trouble with your MSVU username, contact IT&S: 902.457.6538 or visit them in the Library.

MSVU Student ID card

As a new Mount student, you are required to obtain an official MSVU Student ID card. This will be your key to accessing many services across campus, including:

- Your meal plan (Rosaria Dining Hall)
- U-Pass - Your bus pass for the year
- Gym membership
- Library services

Photo ID's are issued in the EMF Library

The Library staff print and renew the Mount ID Cards.

If you are a new student and have registered for your classes, please come to the Library starting the day after registration, as the system takes one day to update.

If you are a returning student, stop by anytime with your current card and the Library staff will place the new validation sticker. If you have lost your card, a new one can be printed for \$10.

WHAT IS POD?

POD stands for Pulse On Dining. It's our exclusive dining program that includes all-you-care-to-eat dining and myPantry. All-you-care-to-eat means once you swipe into the dining hall for a meal, you can eat as much as it takes to satisfy your hunger. You can hangout in the dining hall all day if you wish - just remember to re-swipe when the meal service time changes. myPantry is a self-serve kitchen located right in our dining hall. Students are encouraged to prepare their own food with friends from a full-stocked fridge and pantry. A grocery list is available if something important is missing from the kitchen!

I DON'T LIVE IN RESIDENCE, CAN I EAT IN ROSARIA DINING HALL?

Yes! Everyone is welcome to dine in Rosaria Dining Hall. Pay door prices or purchase a Swipe & Save Dining Plan. Dining Hall Prices (Tax Included):

CAN I TAKE FOOD OUT OF THE DINING HALL?

Sorry, you are not allowed to take food out of Rosaria Dining Hall. These plans are for food that is consumed in the dining room only.

CAN I LEND MY CARD TO A FRIEND OR PURCHASE A MEAL FOR A FRIEND?

Commuter plans are based on swipes of the card so if you would like to invite a friend to dine with you we would welcome the opportunity to serve them. The Ultimate 5 Day and Ultimate 7 Day plans can only be used by the subscriber. If you have a family member or friend visiting and wish to dine with them at Rosaria Dining Hall, your guest is welcome to pay at the door, purchase one of our Dining Plans. You can also treat your guest to a meal by using your Dining Dollars.

CAN I CARRY MY DINING PLAN FORWARD PER YEAR OR TERM?

All Swipe & Save Dining Plans can be carried forward from year to year. Residential Dining Plans expire at the end of the school year (April 2018). Please check with Chartwells or Residence Life for complete details.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I FORGET MY CARD?

Your activated student card is the key to the whole dining plan system. If you forget it you will have to pay cash to gain access to the dining hall. The security of a card remains the cardholder's responsibility. Cards should be treated like a credit or debit card. If a card is lost or stolen the cardholder is responsible for all charges made to that card until the card is reported lost or stolen. A card can be reported lost or stolen at the Chartwells office.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CARD IS LOST OR STOLEN?

Report your lost or stolen ID card to the Chartwells Office (Room 305 in Rosaria Student Centre) so your personal dining plan can be deactivated. A new ID card must be purchased at the MSVU library. Email or visit the Chartwells office to ensure your dining plan reactivation has taken place.
