Research Workshop

Funding Initiatives

- SRSF has been awarded two DFO Science Horizon internships one for SRSF and another for the Georges Bay Ecosystem Project.
- HRDC Internship Applications deadline is March 31st and signatures are needed from all community partners. This funding would supplement intern salaries and increase their travel budgets. CRCs should start looking for interns (placing ads in papers) and setting up interviews. Interns are scheduled to begin work on May 1st.
- Next funding opportunity to be worked on in the immediate future is the HRDC Applied Social Research Grant.
- ACOA SRSF is well positioned as a consortia of community groups to go after funding from them.
- Southern Gulf Coalition ISAR putting through proposal for Georges Bay can align ourselves with this, should have Chedabucto Bay Project
