Guidelines and procedures for applications for reimbursement of expenses incurred by graduate and doctoral students to participate in a conference:

The Graduate Studies Scholarships, Assistantships and Awards Committee has allocated funding to support graduate who are presenting their thesis research at scholarly conferences.

The following conference related expenses are eligible for reimbursement:

- . transportation costs
- . accommodations
- . conference registration

Master's students are eligible for a one-time only allocation of up to \$250. Doctoral students are eligible to receive up to \$250 per year over a four year period.

To be eligible students must:

- 1. be registered in a thesis-based Master's program or a doctoral program,
- 2. have the approval of their thesis supervisor,
- 3. submit a completed application form along with receipts for approval and reimbursement.

Please note that funding is limited. Applications will be approved subject to funding availability.
