




### Job scams

- Be suspicious of all unexpected emails, even when from @msvu.ca
- Research employers before applying
- Beware of jobs that are too good to be true
- Know what is a normal hiring process
- Never deposit cheques or etransfers for an employer. Don't etransfer money to your employer.
- Don't pay for expenses using your own money
- Report suspicious emails to phishing@msvu.ca.

# Student Works – Am I eligible?

### Make sure you meet these criteria:

- Demonstrate financial need by filling out the Fall/Winter 2025-26 Student Works Budget Sheet (Excel file)
- Be a MSVU student for the 2025-26 academic year and registered in 1.5 units in both the Fall and Winter terms (1.0 unit in each term if registered with Accessibility Services)
- If a domestic student, must have either a government student loan, sponsorship, or bank funding (if applicable)

- Be living in Canada and available to work on campus
- Have a valid Canadian social insurance number and bank account
- Hold a valid study permit (if you're an international student)

- One resume (PDF preferred) with your name in the file name
- One cover letter (PDF preferred) with your name in the file name.
   (Departments where you apply will review this cover letter)

- If a domestic student, must provide proof of Student Loan or Student Line of Credit
- A list of the MSVU Career Connects
   Job ID numbers, position titles, and
   departments where you'd like to
   apply
- Email your completed package to financial.aid@msvu.ca by Friday, September 19 at 12 p.m. noon

# Quick tips for applying

Check out the <u>MSVU Career Services Resume</u> and <u>Cover Letter Handbook</u> for visual examples and explanations

Cover letter = one page. If using AI, make sure to edit and insert details specific to you and your experience. Use the <u>STAR Technique</u> to show how you work.

Resume = one or two pages. Use accomplishment statements (like a mini STAR Technique) to show how you work
