

# International Education Centre Co-op Work Permit Application

In order to apply for a co-op/internship/practicum work permit you must be registered in a degree program that requires you to work for at least one term and will receive academic credit during this work term. You must have a valid study permit when you apply. You should apply for your co-op work permit at least 6-8 months before you are scheduled to begin your work term as processing time can vary.

1. Log in to your online immigration account using GCkey or Sign-in Partner If you are a new user, you will need to create your account through GCKey or Sign-in Partner at <a href="https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/application/account.html">https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/application/account.html</a>

**NOTE:** Save your username and password. Consider taking a screenshot of all your security questions and answers to avoid getting locked out of your account. Once you are locked out of your account, you will never be able to access it ever again.


2. Under "Start Application" complete the 'Apply to come to Canada' questionnaire:





## **INSTRUCTIONS**: You need to download the Adobe Acrobat Reader application to your computer.

Under <u>Application Form(s)</u>. Click on the document "Application to Change Conditions...". After clicking it, a new webpage will open up. The webpage will say "Please Wait...". You don't have to wait. Immediately press the download button of your web browser. Save the PDF file on your laptop. Go to the folder where you saved the file. Right click on the file and choose "Open with Adobe Acrobat" PDF Reader. Fill it out using a computer and not by hand/print.

### Medical Exam

**IMPORTANT:** in-Canada applications only

IRCC created a <u>temporary public policy</u> for immigration medical exams (IMEs) <u>until October 6, 2024 only.</u> If you completed an IME within the past 5 years, submit a copy of your previous medical exam.

To qualify for this temporary policy, you must meet **all** of these conditions:

- You applied, or are applying, for either permanent residence or temporary residence.
- You already live in Canada.
- You completed your previous IME in the last 5 years.
- Your previous IME indicated a low risk or no risk to public health or public safety.

**NOTE:** You need to submit your proof of medical exam performed by an IRCC approved physician if you plan to work in the fields of education, childcare, medical and healthcare services, nursing homes, taking care of elderly and other vulnerable people, hospital, and agriculture, etc. Click on this link to view the list of IRCC approved physicians by country to book your appointment if necessary.

## 6. Submit the application. Co-op Work Permit is free.



Once your application has been successfully transmitted, you will receive a confirmation of application submission under "My Messages" or on your home account page.
