

International Education Centre Post Graduation Work Permit Application

You must apply for the Post-Graduation Work Permit with a valid Study Permit and within 90 days of receiving your Eligibility to Graduate Letter/Program Completion letter. **Important**: as soon as you receive all your final grades, you MUST request this letter from the Registrar's Office as it is not automatically issued to students who are graduating.

NOTE: if you missed the 90-day period or if your Study Permit has expired please contact your Immigration Advisor.

1. Log in to your online immigration account using GCkey or Sign-in Partner

If you are a new user, you will need to create your account through GCKey or Sign-in Partner at https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/application/account.html

NOTE: Save your username and password. Consider taking a screenshot of all your security questions and answers to avoid getting locked out of your account. Once you are locked out of your account, you will never be able to access it ever again.





INSTRUCTIONS: You need to download the Adobe Acrobat Reader application to your computer.

Under <u>Application Form(s)</u>. Click on the document "Application to Change Conditions...". After clicking it, a new webpage will open up. The webpage will say "Please Wait...". You don't have to wait. Immediately press the download button of your web browser. Save the PDF file on your laptop. Go to the folder where you saved the file. Right click on the file and choose "Open with Adobe Acrobat" PDF Reader. Fill it out using a computer and not by hand/print.

- Digital photo
- Passport scan all pages that are marked/stamped/with visa. Save multiple pages as 1 PDF file.
- Eligibility to Graduate Letter/Program Completion Letter. Submit Letter Request to the Registrar's Office.
- Official transcripts (Registrar's Office).
- Letter of explanation (if necessary) upload this in the section 'Client Information'
- Medical exam (optional)
- Study Permit
- If you are applying for your spouse's/partner's Open Work Permit, please include proof of your current employement.

Program Completion Letter and Official Transcripts

For the Program Completion Letter/Eligibility to Graduate Letter, you have to fill out the <u>Letter Request</u> Form and email it to <u>heather.standing@msvu.ca</u>

NOTE: When filling out the form, you must check these 3 choices:

- Eligibility to Graduate
- Visa Letter
- and Other option box of Visa Letter, you should write "Post-Graduation Work Permit".

For Official Transcripts, you can go in-person to receive it right away OR you can fill out the <u>Transcript</u> <u>Request Form</u> and email it to <u>transcripts@msvu.ca</u>.

Medical Exam

IMPORTANT: in-Canada applications only

IRCC created a <u>temporary public policy</u> for immigration medical exams (IMEs) <u>until October 6, 2024 only.</u> If you completed an IME within the past 5 years, submit a copy of your previous medical exam.

To qualify for this temporary policy, you must meet all of these conditions:

- You applied, or are applying, for either permanent residence or temporary residence.
- You already live in Canada.
- You completed your previous IME in the last 5 years.
- Your previous IME indicated a low risk or no risk to public health or public safety.

NOTE: You need to submit your proof of medical exam performed by an IRCC approved physician if you plan to work in the fields of education, childcare, medical and healthcare services, nursing homes, taking care of elderly and other vulnerable people, hospital, and agriculture, etc. Click on this link to <u>view</u> the list of IRCC approved physicians by country to book your appointment if necessary.




6. Pay the application fee with a credit card or visa/mastercard debit



7. Submit the application

Once your application has been successfully transmitted, you will receive a confirmation of application submission under "My Messages" or on your home account page.

POST-GRADUATION WORK PERMIT TIMELINE:



- your study i crime was valid during your i own application
- you meet off-campus work authorization requirements,
- you maintained full-time status, except final semester,
- AND you did not work more than the authorized number of hours while studying.
- ✓ If you meet the working requirements above, you can work full time until a decision is made on your application.

Post-Graduation Immigration Support Program

The Post–Graduation Immigration Support Program aims to support international graduates in Nova Scotia by providing instructional information on immigration programs and personalized immigration coaching.



To be eligible for an immigration advising session, individuals must:

- Have finished their studies at a post-secondary institution in Nova Scotia in the past two years;
- · Possess a Post-Graduation Work Permit or proof of application for one; and
- Have a job or job offer from a Nova Scotian employer for a position based and taxed in the province.
