



## Study Permit Restoration inside Canada

**Only use this guide if your Study Permit has already expired and if it is within 90 days of expiry.** If your permit is still valid, please use the guide 'Study Permit Renewal Guide'. If your Study Permit has expired for more than 90 days, please book an appointment with the International Education Centre ASAP.

**NOTE:** that if your passport is expiring, you must apply for a new passport before applying for your study permit.

### 1. Log in to your online immigration account using GKey or Sign-in Partner

*\*If you are a new user, you will need to create your account through GKey or Sign-in Partner.*

**NOTE:** Save your username and password. Consider taking a screenshot of all your security questions and answers to avoid getting locked out of your account. Once you are locked out of your account, you will never be able to access it ever again.

#### Start an application

##### Apply to come to Canada

Includes applications for visitor visas, work and study permits, Express Entry and International Experience Canada. You will need your personal reference code if you have one.

##### Refugees: Apply for temporary health care benefits

Use this application if you are a protected person or refugee claimant who wants to apply for the Interim Federal Health Program.

##### Citizenship: Apply for a search or proof of citizenship

Use this application to apply for proof of citizenship (citizenship certificate) or to search citizenship records.

Even though you are already in Canada, you have to choose this option in order to Start an Application.

In the past 10 years, have you given your fingerprints and photo (biometrics) for an application to come to Canada?	Dependent on your situation. If you have not given biometrics, you will be asked to give them at the closest collection centre. Appointment required plus \$85 in fees.
There are fees associated with this application. Will you be paying your fees or are you fee exempt?	Yes, I will be paying my application fees.
Are you able to make a digital copy of your documents with a scanner or camera?	Yes.
Will you pay your application fees online using a Visa, Mastercard, Visa/Mastercard debit?	Yes. If you don’t have a credit card, you can purchase a pre-paid visa.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** You need to download the Adobe Acrobat Reader software to your computer that runs Windows or Mac OS. Do not use a Chromebook, tablet, or phone.

**Note:** When filling out the form, you must choose **all** of the following options:

- Visa Letter
- Extension of permit renewal
- and Other option box of Visa Letter, you should write 'Study Permit'.

For Official Transcripts, you can go in-person to receive it right away OR you can fill out the [Transcript Request Form](#) and email it to [transcripts@msvu.ca](mailto:transcripts@msvu.ca).



## Medical Exam

**IMPORTANT:** in-Canada applications only

IRCC created a [temporary public policy](#) for immigration medical exams (IMEs) **until October 5, 2029 only**. If you completed an IME within the past 5 years, submit a copy of your previous medical exam.

To qualify for this temporary policy, you must meet **all** of these conditions:

- You applied, or are applying, for either permanent residence or temporary residence.
- You already live in Canada.
- You completed your previous IME in the last 5 years.
- Your previous IME indicated a low risk or no risk to public health or public safety.

**NOTE:** You need to submit your proof of medical exam performed by an IRCC approved physician if you plan to work in the fields of education, childcare, medical and healthcare services, nursing homes, taking care of elderly and other vulnerable people, hospital, and agriculture, etc. Click on this link to [view the list of IRCC approved physicians by country](#) to book your appointment if necessary.
