Renewing your Temporary Resident Visa under a Study Permit status.

You may have to apply to renew your TRV if your will expires soon and you want to leave the country. If your passport and Study Permit are expiring, it is best that you renew your both before applying for a TRV. Moreover, you must have a valid Study Permit before applying for your TRV. You can renew your TRV in Canada by applying online and sending your passport to Ottawa.

1. Log in to your online immigration account using GCKey or Sign-in Partner

If you are a new user, you will need to create your account through GCKey or Sign-in Partner at <https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/application/account.html>

NOTE: Save your username and password. Consider taking a screenshot of all your security questions and answers to avoid getting locked out of your account. Once you are locked out of your account, you will never be able to access it ever again.

2. Under “Start Application” complete the ‘Apply to come to Canada’ questionnaire:

Apply to come to Canada

Includes applications for visitor visas, work and study permits, Express Entry and International Experience Canada. You will need your personal reference code if you have one.

Refugees: Apply for temporary health care benefits

Use this application if you are a protected person or refugee claimant who wants to apply for the Interim Federal Health Program.

Citizenship: Apply for a search or proof of citizenship

Use this application to apply for proof of citizenship (citizenship certificate) or to search citizenship records.

Even though you are already in Canada, you have to choose this option in order to Start an Application.

You have to Determine your eligibility to apply online for a Visitor/Study/Work Permit.

I do not have a Personal Reference Code

If you do not have a personal reference code, you may answer a series of questions to find out if you are eligible to apply for a visa and/or permit, apply for Express Entry, and begin an online application.

If you begin your application **after you have logged into your account**, you will not receive a personal reference code, as the system will save your document checklist right into your account.

Determine your eligibility and apply online:

Visitor visa, study and/or work permit

Express Entry (EE)

International Experience Canada (IEC)

Choose this option.

If you do not see this option, that means you have an existing/open application that you have not yet submitted.

Go back to the main page of your account and look under "Continue an application you haven't submitted" to view your existing application.

Under Application Form(s), Click on the document “Application to Change Conditions...”. After clicking it, a new webpage will open up. The webpage will say “Please Wait...”. You don't have to wait. Immediately press the download button of your web browser. Save the PDF file on your laptop. Go to the folder where you saved the file. Right click on the file and choose “Open with Adobe Acrobat” PDF Reader. Fill it out using a computer and not by hand/print.

Medical Exam

IMPORTANT: in-Canada applications only

IRCC created a [temporary public policy](#) for immigration medical exams (IMEs) **until October 6, 2024 only**. If you completed an IME within the past 5 years, submit a copy of your previous medical exam.

To qualify for this temporary policy, you must meet **all** of these conditions:

- You applied, or are applying, for either permanent residence or temporary residence.
- You already live in Canada.
- You completed your previous IME in the last 5 years.
- Your previous IME indicated a low risk or no risk to public health or public safety.

NOTE: You need to submit your proof of medical exam performed by an IRCC approved physician if you plan to work in the fields of education, childcare, medical and healthcare services, nursing homes, taking care of elderly and other vulnerable people, hospital, and agriculture, etc. Click on this link to [view the list of IRCC approved physicians by country](#) to book your appointment if necessary.

6. Pay the application fee with a credit card or visa/mastercard debit

7. Submit the application.

Once your application has been successfully transmitted, you will receive a confirmation of application submission under “My Messages” or on your home account page.

8. Wait for a response from IRCC and mail your passport within 30 days of approval.

Once your application has been processed, IRCC will send you a letter under "My Messages" in your online account. Please **print the passport request letter** and mail it along with your passport

Go to a Canada Post Office and **purchase two prepaid Xpresspost envelopes (1 big and 1 small) with tracking numbers.**

In the bigger envelope, put in your passport, IRCC Letter Request for Passport, and the other smaller envelope you purchased. This smaller envelope will be used to return your passport with your new TRV to you.
