
# **COVID-19 MARITIME FAMILY SURVEY SURVEY 1** PRELIMINARY RESULTS (APRIL/MAY 2020)

# RESPONDENTS



Survey was for families with children aged 0-8 years.

**1937** reported doing paid work and/or being a registered student prior to COVID-19.

#### The majority of respondents indicated:

- They identify as mothers (90%)
- They have a child/children aged 3-5 years old (59%)
- Their child/children attended child care or Preprimary (69%) and/or school (46%) prior to COVID-19 closures


#### **BALANCING WORK & FAMILY**

of respondents still working/studying reported they are doing so from home **76%** reported they are doing so from while also balancing parenting responsibilities




strongly agree that balancing 63% work/study & parenting has been challenging

#### FAMILY LIFE & PARENTS

reported a moderate to extreme 86% change in their family life due to the COVID-19 pandemic

**70%** of families are playing together more

... and 51% of families are cooking together more

of parents indicated they have 68% less time to take care of themselves

> ... and 63% of parents indicated they feel less rested

reported a loss of health-related service for their child



indicated their child has been spending more time using screens
