

# SUSTAINABILITY AT MSVU

The average home consumes 65 gigajoules in energy each year for heating purposes.



Since 2010, MSVU has reduced its fuel consumption by the equivalent of 70 homes annually.



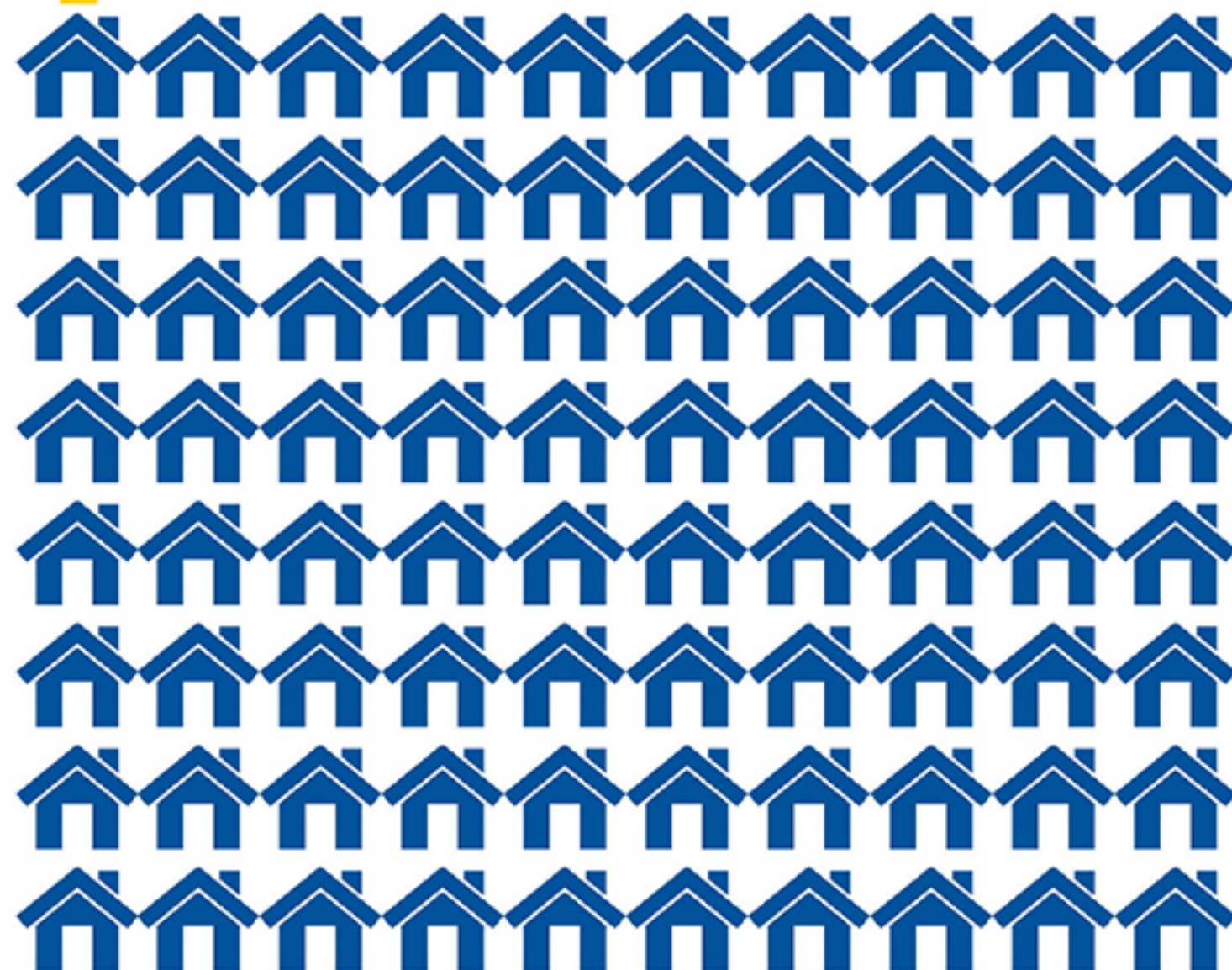
MSVU averages more than 25 tonnes of paper and cardboard being recycled and diverted from the landfill annually\*.

\*This doesn't include confidential paper shredding services.

Through our bi-weekly Shred-it services we saved 470 trees in 2020 by diverting paper from landfills to be recycled.

A three bedroom bungalow uses approx. 12,000 KWH of power a year.

Since 2010, we've added 75,000 sq ft of occupied space to campus and yet continue to remove the equivalent of 80 houses worth of electrical consumption from the power grid each year.



Over the last decade we saved an estimated 10,560,000 KWH just in case you're counting.



Through the implementation of several initiatives, we've reduced our water consumption by an average of 37,000 cubic meters annually.

That's 168,000 filled bath tubs or 275,000 ten-minute showers each year.
