Student Works Program

- Flexible work hours on campus work between classes
- Manage your time and multiple responsibilities
- On campus employers understand your needs
- Add to your career-related skills or transferable skills
- Gain references for future work or education applications



To be eligible for Student Works

- Demonstrate financial need by completing the Student Works application (Financial Aid form + cover letter + resume)
- Be a FULL time Mount student for the 2021-22 academic year
- Be living in Canada
- Have a valid Canadian social insurance number and bank account
- Hold a valid study permit (if an international student)

- Jobs posted NOW, due Thursday,
 September 16 at 12 p.m.
- Part-time: 12 hours/week during the academic year
- Pay: \$14/hour

Summer Jobs

- Jobs posted in March 2022
- Full-time: 35 hours/week

How to apply to Student Works

- Login to Career Connects
 https://careerconnects.msvu.ca/home.htm with your Mount email and password. Contact helpdesk@msvu.ca if you can't get in.
- 2. Follow the instructions in the job application. Send your application package in one email (cover letter(s) + resume + Financial Aid form) before Thurs. Sept. 16 at 12 p.m.
- 3. If you qualify, your cover letter and resume will be sent to departments where you applied. Departments decide who and when to interview in the week of September 20.
- 4. Jobs start Monday, September 27.

Quick tips for applying

- Check out Career Services' Resume and Cover Letter Handbook for samples and suggestions https://www.msvu.ca/wp-content/uploads/2021/05/Resume-and-Cover-Letter-Handbook-FINAL-MAY-2021.pdf
- Cover letter = one page. ALWAYS tailor your cover letter to the job you're applying for. Mention your program and year of study.
- Resume = one or two pages
- Explain how you connect to the job and your past experience
