REQUIRED AND OPTIONAL ESSAYS**

The following 3 required essays and one optional essay must be formatted as follows.

- Paper size: 8.5 x 11 inches
- Minimum borders: 1 inch
- Minimum font size: 11 point
- Spacing: double-spaced (not single or 1.5 lines)
- Maximum length: 1 page (double-spaced)
- The title and your name must appear at the top of page 1 in the header

Personal Statement

Please provide some information about your background with an emphasis on describing how you came to decide that a program that focuses on school and child clinical psychology is a good match for your interests. Please describe specific experiences and/or knowledge that you have gathered about the field to support your statement.

Practice and Development of the Profession Statement
