

10 Things to consider with Online Exams:

1. Know the professor's expectations for the exam.
2. Be familiar with the exam platform: Moodle, McGraw Hill Connect, etc.
3. What accessibility features are provided/needed?
4. When will you have access to the exam?
5. How much time will you have to write the exam?
6. Do you need to complete the exam in one chunk? Or can you take a break and return to the exam?
7. Can you skip questions and come back to them later?
8. What types of questions will be on the exam? e.g., multiple choice, short answer, application, etc.
9. What materials are you allowed to use? Textbook? Notes? Internet?
10. How can you ask for clarification once you've started writing?
