- 10 Things to consider with Online Exams:
 - 1. Know the professor's expectations for the exam.
 - 2. Be familiar with the exam platform: Moodle, McGraw Hill Connect, etc.
 - 3. What accessibility features are provided/needed?
 - 4. When will you have access to the exam?
 - 5. How much time will you have to write the exam?
 - 6. Do you need to complete the exam in one chunk? Or can you take a break and return to the exam?
 - 7. Can you skip questions and come back to them later?
 - 8. What types of questions will be on the exam? e.g., multiple choice, short answer, application, etc.
 - 9. What materials are you allowed to use? Textbook? Notes? Internet?
 - 10. How can you ask for clarification once you've started writing?
