### GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist the Day Camp Coordinators in the planning and implementation of camp plans.
- Provide a positive, energetic environment through individual enthusiasm.
- Work closely with campers and develop positive relationship with them.
- Create and maintain a safe environment for the campers and staff.
- Provide first aid to campers as needed.
- Help maintain cleanliness of camp areas.
- Provide feedback to parents of campers.
- Implement disciplinary action as required.
- Adhere to the Policies and Procedures outlined in training.
- Other duties as required.

### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a current university student with experience working with children ages 5-11.
- Must be energetic, patient and have a sense of humor.
- Must be able to accept supervision and guidance from the Camp Supervisor and Coordinators.
- Previous camp experience is an asset.
- Must be able to complete a range of physical activities, such as lifting moderately heavy equipment, participate in camp activities and other functions essential to the job, with or without reasonable accommodation.
- Must have or obtain a certification in Emergency First Aid and CPR Level C.\*
- Must complete a current Criminal Records & Vulnerable Sector Check\* and Child Abuse Registry Check.\*
