Role Overview:

The Day Camp Inclusion Support Leader will be responsible for the daily supervision of children in our day camp program who require one-on-one support. Responsibilities include ensuring each child's personal and developmental needs are met, making necessary modifications to include them in all camp activities, and ensuring their overall safety and well-being while in our care. This position reports daily to the Recreation Coordinator and Camp Coordinators. A strong knowledge of a wide range of recreational activities is required.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide one-on-one care and support based on individual needs
- Assist with personal care as required
- Modify activities to support inclusion
- Communicate daily with parents/guardians and team members
- Address issues as they arise and report concerns to supervisors
- Complete additional duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Current university student with experience working with children (ages 5–11)
- Preferred fields: Education, Child & Youth Studies, Recreation, or related
- Experience supporting children with diverse needs and adapting activities
- Strong communication, leadership, and teamwork skills
- Ability to perform physical tasks as required

Requirements:

- Emergency First Aid & CPR Level C (or willingness to obtain)
- Criminal Records & Vulnerable Sector Check and Child Abuse Registry Check*
