


How do I login?



Payment Due Dates are found in the myMount account under the Money Matters tile or at msvu.ca/tuition.

Students must pay the required fee instalment by each term's payment deadlines (listed below) in order to complete their registration and keep their course selections for that term.

Payment deadlines:

Summer 1 Term – May 6, 2024 Summer 2 Term – June 25, 2024



Payment Options

Electronic payment preferred:

 Within Canada – internet banking using bill payment functionality – use 7 digit student number when prompted for account number

International payments – preferred option Convera for students (formerly Global Pay for Students) – also have bank wire option

Allow 2 to 3 days for receipt and posting

Credit cards are not accepted for tuition and residence payments



Withdrawal from Classes

- May 5, 2024 last date to drop Summer 1 classes without academic or financial penalty
- Refund Schedule Applies after the first day of class with declining prorated refund
- If you decide not to attend or visa not approved, make sure you drop your courses by May 5, 2024

□ Automatically charged - \$230.50 for May 1/24 to Aug 31/24

Opt Outs:

- $\checkmark\,$ If you are taking courses from out of country
 - Complete opt out form email <u>financial.services@msvu.ca</u> no later than May 17, 2024
- ✓ If you are covered under MSI (Nova Scotia Medical Services Insurance)
 - Send copy of MSI card to <u>financial.services@msvu.ca</u> by May 17, 2024
 - Effective date must be May 1/24 or earlier
 - If expiry date is before Aug 31/24 will need to send copy of replacement card before expiry

Who is eligible for the U-Pass?

All graduate and undergraduate students who are registered full-time in credit course work at MSVU in the term for which the U-Pass is being issued, will receive a U-Pass.



U-Pass Fee – summer term





U-PASS Program

□ Provides unlimited bus service in HRM – most routes no additional cost

□ Pick up your ID Card from the Library

Once you have your ID card, go to Financial Services in Evaristus Hall to get the U-PASS sticker if eligible

□ Can only opt out if you are 100% in online courses or on a co-op work term outside of Halifax Regional Municipality



This form must be completed by the student in order for a parent or additional persons, other than the student, to have access to that student's enrolment and financial information,
