

2024 - 2025 Undergraduate Entrance Bursary

Mount Saint Vincent University's Undergraduate Entrance Bursary Program is intended to help students by supplementing their own financial contribution and that of their families toward their education. The program is not intended to replace these contributions; nor is it intended for students with sufficient resources to cover their academic year.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for an MSVU Undergraduate Entrance Bursary, you must be able to check (and provide confirmation) for ALL of the following:

I have been accepted to MSVU for the 2024-2025 academic year and will start classes in September 2024 (Students who begin courses at the Mount before the Fall 2024 term will not be eligible to receive an Undergraduate Entrance Bursary).
I will be taking a minimum 60% course load during the academic year; i.e., the equivalent of three half-units in the Fall semester and three half-units in the Winter semester.
I have applied for a government student loan OR I plan to apply for a government student loan OR I have applied for a private bank student line of credit.
FUNDING MUST BE IN PLACE BY AUGUST 14, 2024 so apply as soon as applications open!
I am entering my first undergraduate degree, or transferring from another postsecondary institution and have not yet completed a degree.

Confirmation of Need Form:

Students who are awarded Undergraduate Entrance Bursary will be required to complete a Confirmation of Need form and return it to the Financial Aid Office no later than Wednesday, August 14, 2024. This form will be mailed to eligible students with their Entrance Bursary offer in July. Any Undergraduate Entrance bursary awarded will be considered relinquished if the Confirmation of Need form is not received by August 14. Once the Confirmation of Need form is approved, the bursary will be applied 50% to the Fall term and 50% to the Winter term.

The Undergraduate Entrance Bursary consists of 5 pages. Please review carefully. Incomplete applications will be ineligible.
